The school's Parents and Citizens Association has lodged a grant application with the NSW Government to fund an exciting fixed playground initiative.

While our school and its facilities are new and outstanding, one missing feature is equipment for children to play on during break time. The cost of purchasing equipment outright is prohibitive which is why the grant is critically important to the project's success.

As this is a community grant, it is community members who will determine which projects receive funding and which ones do not. This is occurring through a process of public voting.

Our project is 'competing' against other projects from within the Castle Hill NSW state electorate. Only the projects within the Castle Hill electorate that receive the most votes will be funded.

The reason I am writing is to encourage you to vote and twist the arms of all friends and family members who live within the electorate to also vote. Unfortunately the voting process is quite involved. It can take up to 10 minutes as the website requires those who are voting to identify themselves and prove that they reside in the electorate. The electoral roll is cross-referenced with Medicare numbers.

Please do not be deterred by this process. It is a necessary check to ensure that the projects selected have been chosen on merit and not because one individual voted thousands of times.
