## BUSHFIRE UPDATE – NORTH KELLYVILLE PS OPEN

Dear Parents / Carers,

North Kellyville Public School **will remain open** despite the increased bushfire threat this week. North Kellyville Public School has a comprehensive emergency management plan which will be enacted if required. The school is not in an area classified as bush fire prone and has been assessed as being safe to attend.

You might hear through social media, news services, friends or family that many other metropolitan schools will be closed tomorrow, Tuesday 12 November. These schools are in an area with a greater degree of risk and they are only closing due to extreme caution.

Although North Kellyville Public School will remain open, parents may wish to keep their children at home due to the heightened risk and poor air quality. In these circumstances, parents are reminded to send an explanatory note or use the School Stream absence notification form to advise. Absences will be recorded as approved leave.

Students will be kept indoors at school where air quality is poor and extreme heat is evident.
