



# TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN GUIDE

**Woolworths**

The 40km school zone commences / concludes south of Curtis/Camrose.

Mossop Way is **NO PARKING**. Parents of support classes may access the special drop off zone within school grounds but must not park on the street or obstruct driveways.

Thorogood Blvd is for service vehicles (waste) ONLY. There is **NO** pedestrian access.

**NO STOPPING ANY TIME**

Kiss & Drop is a **NO PARKING** zone during drop off & pick up. Parents may stop for 2 minutes and must remain within 3 metres of their vehicle. If child is not present at pick up, do a loop and return.

The 40km school zone commences / concludes outside Scribbles.

The pedestrian crossing is signposted and supervised by RMS crossing supervisors.

Hipwell Avenue has marked, un-timed parking bays and is recommended for drop off & pick up.

There is **NO PARKING** in Scribbles kindy. This is for the safety of pre-schoolers. This is private property and NKPS parents must not park there.

Parking Rules & Penalties Fact Sheet  
**DRIVEWAYS**



**You must not park your car over or block access to a driveway.**

You can stop in a driveway to drop off or pick up passengers BUT only for less than 2 minutes AND the driver must stay with the car.

**SCHOOL ZONE**

Penalty from \$173 and 2 demerit points

**NO PARKING**



**You can stop only to drop off or pick up passengers or goods and you must not stop for more than 2 minutes and The driver must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle**

**Road safety**



**Your guide to driving and parking safely near schools**

The beginning and end of the school day are busy times for pedestrians and vehicles outside the school. That's why you need to take extra care in 40km/h school zones.

- Park safely and legally, even if it means walking further to the school gate. Parking signs are planned with children's safety in mind.
- Slow down to 40km/h in the school zone and stay aware of crossings.
- Always park and turn legally around the school.
- Never double park as it puts children at risk.
- Manoeuvres such as U-turns and three-point turns are dangerous.
- Never park in a bus zone or in the school bus bay.
- Make sure your children use the Safety Door (rear footpath side door) to get in and out of the car.
- At a supervised crossing, observe the directions of the school crossing supervisor.
- Model safe and considerate behaviour for your child – they will learn from you.

Remember to always give way to pedestrians particularly when entering and leaving driveways. Don't park across the school driveway or the entrance to the school car park. It's always a good idea to use the drop off and pick up area suggested by your school. This will help keep all children as safe as possible during the busiest times of the school day.
