Hipwell Ave- Temporary No Parking Restrictions

The Hills Shire Council have installed temporary 'No Parking 8 - 9.30am and 2.30 - 4pm school days' restrictions on the eastern side of Hipwell Ave between Curtis Rd and the end of the Kiss and Drop Zone to assist in relieving some of the congestion getting in and out of the road at peak times. These parking restrictions will be removed when the Kiss and Drop Zone relocates back onto Hezlett Road. Please see image below.



Thorogood Bvd – Pedestrian Access

Thorogood Bvd is open for pedestrian access before and after school. This is **NOT A KISS & DROP FACILITY** and we ask for all of the school community to follow the road rules to allow this entry to remain open. It is a clearly signposted **NO STOPPING** area. Please do not drive to the end of Thorogood Bvd and drop your child/ren at the gate. Please be respectful of our neighbours by not parking across their driveways. The gate will only be opened at 8.30am until 9am in the morning and at 3pm until 3.15pm in the afternoon. Access to the site during the day will remain through the Hezlett Rd and Hipwell Ave gates.

Get Tested!

Parents are reminded that any student or staff member with cold or flu-like symptoms must stay home, be tested, return a negative result and be symptom-free before returning to school. Road Works

Thank you to the vast majority of parents and community members who have been patient and are following the correct road rules to ensure our students' safety. It has been great to see a number of people opting to "park & walk".

Key points to remember:

- **No kiss and drop facility on Hezlett Road or Thorogood Bvd during construction.**
- **A temporary kiss and drop facility has been installed on Hipwell Avenue** however capacity is much lower. Parents are advised to think carefully about whether kiss and drop is the safest form of drop off and pick up. **Parents who must drive are asked to consider parking and walking into and out of the school.**
- Pedestrian access via Hezlett Road is maintained.
- Hipwell Avenue has double lines. If you are caught doing a u-turn over double lines in a

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Applying for Year 5 entry to an opportunity class in 2022

Opportunity classes cater for academically gifted and high potential Year 5 and Year 6 students. Opportunity classes are offered at 76 public schools in NSW. These classes help gifted and high potential students to learn by grouping them with other students of similar ability, using specialised teaching methods and materials. Students who are placed attend the opportunity class full time in Years 5 and 6.

Applications for Year 5 entry to an opportunity class in 2022 open on Tuesday 20 April and close Friday 7 May 2021. Parents must apply online.

All applicants are required to sit the Opportunity Class Placement Test to be held on Wednesday 21 July 2021.

The Department has introduced a new application system that will give parents a more interactive experience. The new system enables parents to make updates and add attachments even after an application is submitted. Parents can also communicate directly with the High Performing Students Team through the system's new 'messages' feature.

The NKPS P&C 2021 Annual General Meeting was held on Wednesday 17 March 2021. A new executive committee was elected that night, consisting of:

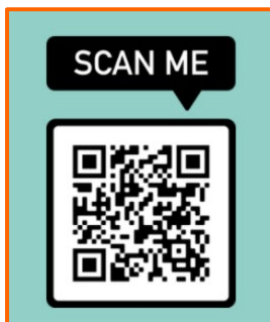

What is Wesley Out of School Hours (Wesley OOSH) vacation care?

Wesley OOSH vacation care provides a fun, social and safe environment for primary school-aged children during the school holidays and pupil free days. We deliver a program that recognises the strengths, interests and uniqueness of every child and provides encouragement for continued growth.

What are the hours of operation?

Vacation care: 7am – 6pm

What are the costs and how do I book?

Wesley OOSH vacation care costs \$47 per day, plus any additional expenses for incursions and excursions. You may be eligible for the child care subsidy for vacation care.

What if I need to cancel?

Cancellations can be made up to seven days prior to the commencement of the session. Fees apply for cancellations after this time.
