## Year 4-6 Camp – Collaroy Centre

**Wednesday 18th September - Friday 20th September 2019**

Dear Parents,

Our Year 4-6 trip to The Collaroy Centre is scheduled for Week 9 of this term. This camp is designed to consolidate students' learning across different Key Learning Areas and assist students in their independence and responsibility.

The camp will be held from **Wednesday 18th September to Friday 20th September**. The cost of the camp is \$330, with some deposits already paid in Term 1 and 2 accounts. The remaining balance **will be included on the Term 3 account. Payment must be made prior**

Students are expected to **be at school no later than 7:45am on the morning of Wednesday 18th September**. We will be returning to school at approximately **3:00pm on Friday 20th September**. Students will need to be picked up promptly at this time. We will notify the community on School Stream if there is a change to this time. Travel is by seat belted coach.

### Activities

Activities may include the following

- Giant swing
- Orienteering
- Archery
- Laser tag
- High ropes
- Flying fox
- Rock climbing

### Luggage

Students should only bring **one travelling case** and one backpack to camp. Students will need to carry their own luggage. Try to keep luggage to essentials. Items needed during travelling should be carried in a smaller backpack style bag. All luggage should be clearly labelled with the student's name and address.

### What to bring to camp

- T-shirts (No singlets or mid-riffs)
- Shorts
- Pants
- Jumpers/Jacket
- Socks
- Underwear
- Sunscreen and sunhat
- Toiletries (including soap)
- Handkerchief or tissues
- Water Bottle
- Raincoat
- One towel
- Sleeping bag or two single bed flat sheets
- Pillow Case
- One pair of sneakers
- Pyjamas
- Plastic bag for dirty or wet clothes
- Medication (if required)
- Thongs to wear in the shower

### Optional:

- Camera (which the student must be responsible for at all times).

### Under no circumstances may:

- Students bring a **mobile phone** in any form or a device with **internet** capabilities.
- Students bring **lollies or other confectionary** items.

### Accommodation

The students will stay in cabin blocks with 6-8 students in each room. Male and female students will be in separate rooms. Students will be given an opportunity to request who they would like to share a cabin with but teachers will allocate the cabins based on the needs of students.

### Behaviour at Camp

Students are on a **school** excursion and are supervised by teachers throughout this time, therefore normal school rules apply. We are looking forward to a wonderful 3 days with a great students. In the event of misbehaviour you as the parent may need to be notified.

### Emergency Contact

If an emergency arises and you need to make contact with the students or teachers at camp please contact the school office during work hours or call The Collaroy Centre afterhours and we will get back in contact with you.

### Keeping Track

We will be keeping the community updated about the adventures at camp through facebook and school stream.

### Medical Information and Medication

Any student requiring medication should bring only enough for the duration of their stay. All medication must be in original packaging which is then placed in a snap lock bag and be clearly marked with the student's name, the advised dosage and the dosage interval. This information should also have been noted on the **medical form** attached. All medication must be handed by the parent to the teacher in the morning of the camp.

### Asthma

It is imperative that parents of children who suffer from asthma provide sufficient information so that staff can take appropriate action in the event of an attack. Students who require inhalers should carry them at all times while at camp.

If you have any questions regarding the camp please speak to your child's teacher or if you require any assistance with finances please arrange a meeting with Mr Moth or Miss McGill.
